1. How do you think you would feel if you had been betrayed by your brothers, sold as a slave, hauled away to another country, falsely accused of something you didn't do, and thrown in prison? Would it be hard for Joseph to trust God's goodness when so many sad things happened?
2. Why did Pharaoh throw the cupbearer and baker into prison?
3. Who helped Joseph understand the dreams of the cupbearer and baker?
4. True or False. Joseph told the cupbearer that he would choke on a cup of poisoned grape juice and the chief baker would once again bake chocolate donuts with sprinkles for Pharaoh's household.

5. How many years passed before the cupbearer remembered Joseph? (Genesis 41:1)
6. Who helped Joseph understand Pharaoh's dream (Genesis 41:16)?
7. Describe a famine to an adult in your house. How long do you think your family could survive on the food stored up in your house?
8. Why did God save Joseph from prison?
9. God is in complete control and sees the big picture. Name one worry you would like to place into God's hands and trust God to be in charge of the big picture?
10. What did you learn about God's character this week?
