Joseph and the Promised Land

- I. After Jacob dies, Joseph's brothers worry that Joseph might hold a grudge and pay the brothers back for all the wrongs they did to him. Have you ever had a brother or sister "pay you back" for being mean? Have you ever held a grudge for a wrong someone did to you?
- 2. In fear, Joseph's brothers send word to Joseph. Read what they said in Genesis 50:16-18. Do you think Joseph's father, Jacob, actually said this or are the brothers making up this story?
- 3. Did Joseph forgive his brothers? Why or why not? Read Genesis 50:19-21 for a BIG hint!
- 4. How did Joseph have faith in God?

- 5. Joseph was able to see that what the bothers intended for evil, God used for good to save Joseph's family and a whole lot of other people from famine. Have you ever seen God use a really hard circumstance in your life to bring about something good?
- 6. Read Genesis 50:22-26. What did Joseph say God would do for the Israelites in the future?
- 7. What does Joseph's story teach you about God's character?
