- 6. Have you ever tried to hide after doing something wrong? Why were Adam and Eve afraid? (Hint: Genesis 3:8-10) What hope do we see in Genesis 3:9?
- 7. In Genesis 3:15, we get a glimpse of God's amazing plan to save us from our sin. The offspring of the woman would crush the head of the serpent. Can you guess who Genesis 3:15 points to?
- 8. When God gives us something good we <u>don't</u> deserve, that is called GRACE. When God holds back the punishment we <u>do</u> deserve for sin, that is called MERCY. How did God show Adam and Eve grace and mercy in Genesis 3:21?
- 9. True or False. God has a rescue plan. In the darkest moments of our lives, God is looking for us (Gen 3:9). He sent Jesus to die for our sins (Gen 3:15). And he is covering us with His love (Gen 3:21).
- 10. Write down one thing you learned about God's character from Genesis 1-3.

Memory Verse: "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and all are justified freely by his grace though the redemption that came by Christ Jesus. God presented Christ as a sacrifice of atonement, though the shedding of his blood-to be received by faith." Romans 3:23-25a

Fun Fact: The word, "Gospel," comes from the Old English word, gōdspel, meaning good (god) story/news (spel). Gōdspel is a translation of the Greek word, "euangelion," which means good announcement. Genesis 3:15 is often called the first glimmer of the gospel (protoevangelium). Check out the video on the meaning of Gospel from the Bible Project.
