- 4. Joseph's brothers don't recognize him, but Joseph remembers them and the dreams he had a long time ago. What is the first thing Joseph's brothers do in his presence?
- 5. True or False. On the brothers' first trip to Egypt for food.

- jail for three days. Spying is what Joseph's brothers originally accused Joseph of doing.
- 6. True of False. Jacob is trapped because of his grief over Joseph. He's resolved that Simeon is gone and terrified of losing Benjamin. The brothers are trapped because they can't tell their father about their sin. Joseph is trapped because he doesn't know whether he can trust his brothers.
- 7. Is there some sin in your past that has you feeling trapped? What can you do about it?
- 8. When all the brothers return to Egypt a second time for more grain, how does Joseph test his brothers?
- True or False. The brothers throw Benjamin "under the bus" and Judah says, "Go ahead and kill Benjamin. He means nothing to us.
- 10. Why did God save Joseph? What would have happened to Jacob and his children if God had not saved Joseph and blessed him in Egypt?
- 11. True or False. Forgiveness can't undo the pain of the past, but it makes a way for our own healing to begin. When we understand how much we have been forgiven through Christ, we will forgive others.
- 12. What is one thing you learned about God's character this week?
