Acts 1:8 Connection: The Callisons in Iraq

- We met with the Duhok governor to ask that the Roger and Harriett Cumberland house become a peace and reconciliation center according to the wishes of Janet Cumberland Shafran. Please pray that Janet's wish for a peace and reconciliation center would be accepted. The governor seemed open!
