Our congregation has long supported the ministry of Rancho Sordo Mundo, started by the Everett family in 1969 as a Christ-centered boarding school for deaf and non-speaking children in the fertile Guadalupe Valley inland from Ensenada, Mexico. RSM continues to serve the Lord by training and supporting ministry partners reaching the deaf for Jesus.

- That ranch wells and pumps continue providing ample water during the summer fire season in Baja California and for protection during the season.
 For wisdom in ministering to deaf-serving ministries and educational partners in Mexico and Guatemala.
- For continued financial support for RSM which remains a deaf-serving ministry, albeit one no longer serving as a boarding school, while growing as a training ground, resource and networking hub in Latin America.
- For a renewed spirit for RMS leaders who miss the lively days when children and teachers lived at the ranch during the school year and when the ranch hosted church groups (including ELMO Pres) which used to visit several times a year.
