**Marilu Villanueva**: In Morelia, Michoacan, Marilu's goal is strengthening families through Bible Study, preventing intrafamily violence, and counseling women going through a rough patch.

**Igelsia Cristo es El Camino:** Our congregation has long joined with this ministry partner, a small community-supporting Presbyterian church in the village of Cañon Buena Vista, south of Ensenada. We provide financial and prayer support for Pastor Noe Perez Gomez and his congregation, many of whom are migrant agricultural workers who come from southern Mexico to work in the farming industry in northern Baja California.

**Rancho Sordo Mundo**: Our church has enjoyed a decades-long relationship with this ministry, which has transitioned in recent years from a boarding school teaching indigenous deaf students to a training ground, resource center and networking hub for ministries that serve the hearing-impaired throughout Latin America. 
